The side item will retail for \$2.19 as an individual item or can be added to a basket for 69 cents.

The Cranberry Walnut Tart is baked with walnuts and locally produced, dried cranberries. It retails for \$2.49.

Burgerville's cranberries are grown by Clearwater Cranberries and Meduri Farm, both locally owned and operated. Along with cranberries, the chain's new menu items also feature bread from Portland French and cage-free eggs from Steibers Farm in Yelm, Wash. The Kentucky Bourbon Baked Beans are sustainably processed locally by [Truitt Brothers](#) in Salem, Ore.
